FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q1. Is VCA accredited?

 No, we do not qualify for accreditation due to our number of enrollment. However, we make every attempt to follow ACSI guidelines to ensure the best standards we possibly can. We are committed to provide students with an exceptional education experience.

Q2. Will your teachers be licensed by the State of Kansas?

• It is not required however; such status may or may not be an identifying mark of a good teacher. We recognize that families desire the best for their students and we will seek the most qualified, college-degreed, Christian teacher. A teacher will not be hired at VCA unless we believe that he or she is gifted.

Q3. What curriculum is used at VCA?

• We use A Beka Book for our core subjects. You may visit their website at www.abeka.com/ChristianSchool/. Every subject is approached from a Christian perspective, and you'll find Scripture and biblical principles used to emphasize or illustrate concepts. Our core subjects include; Math, English/Grammar/Spelling/Lit, Science, History, and Bible. We also use A Beka for electives for our Upper School grade levels but may choose other resources if it is needed. Another product we use from A Beka is Pro Teach. This is streaming video from master-level teachers recorded live from the Pensacola, FL class room. This is a supplemental resource for our teachers and students.

Q4. Does VCA have a sports program?

Opportunities for a variety of sports are available with area Christian organizations.
VCA encourages and will support any interest by students who wish to participate but they must maintain and not go below a "C" average in order for the school to allow early release for games or practices.

Q5. Are school lunches provided?

• Students must pack a school lunch each day. There are special occasions where lunch may be provided.
